Position Title: Patient Services Representative

Summary Description

Lifecor, manufacturer of the world's first wearable defibrillator, is seeking Patient Services Representatives to train patients in the use of the LifeVest. This is the perfect opportunity for the health professional with patient care and teaching experience to moonlight to supplement his or her income. A typical LifeVest patient is in the hospital awaiting discharge, and the PSR sets up the equipment and trains the patient and caregivers in the use of the system. A session normally lasts between one and two hours, and the compensation rate is currently \$150 per patient. PSRs retain the flexibility to accept or decline assignments as their schedules dictate. Most assignments can be scheduled during free time – either before or after work, or on days off.

Major Responsibilities

- Accept or decline assignments based on your availability
- Manage equipment inventory
- Contact caregivers and family to schedule training sessions
- Program equipment according to the physician's orders
- Measure patient and determine correct sizing
- Train the patient and other caregivers in the use of the system
- Have the patient sign an agreement and submit the required paperwork to Lifecor
